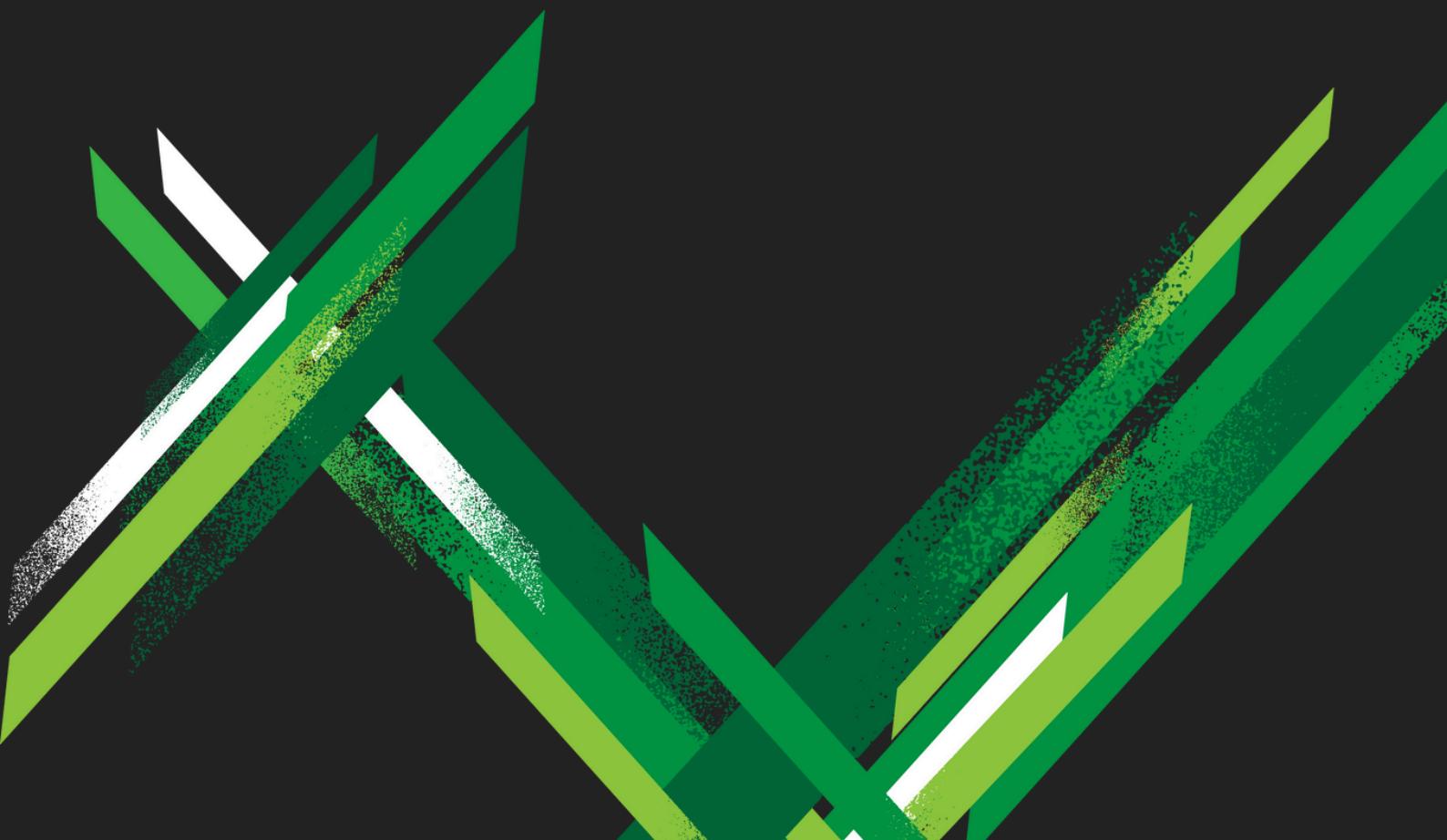

About Us

The Computer Security Group (CSG) is a student organization open to all students. Our members range from those who are preparing for a career in the wide field of security, to those who are pursuing other careers in Computer Science and related fields but would like to know more about matters of security. There are no membership dues or other costs of membership, and we welcome anyone who is interested in computer security.

During the Fall and Spring semesters we hold regular meetings which take a presentation-based format. Many presentations are given by group members on a peer-to-peer basis over what they know, have learned, or are working on. We also welcome guest speakers from companies in related fields and other areas of the university.

A growing focus of our regular activities have been our Open-Lab sessions which are longer than our other meetings, and are a more flexible and open environment where members can work together or solo on expanding their knowledge, work on various security challenges to sharpen skills, or discuss matters of mutual interest with other members. Our other main activities are competing as a team in Capture the Flag (CTF) competitions held by various other universities and companies worldwide (more details below).





CTF Team

CSG has a CTF team comprised of students that compete on a regular basis. These students bring their security skills to work in a team together on Capture-The-Flag (CTF) competitions. The CTF team has reached 8th in the U.S. across academic teams, and are currently 35th in the country.

The CTF team is made up of 23 students who compete every other weekend. Sponsorship would help sustain the team via food catering, and would help the team fund trips to events when qualifying for in-person security competitions.

The CTF team was started by students, for students to foster interest in practical cybersecurity. Since the team's foundation, we have built a strong community of members who love to learn, demonstrate, and teach their skills.

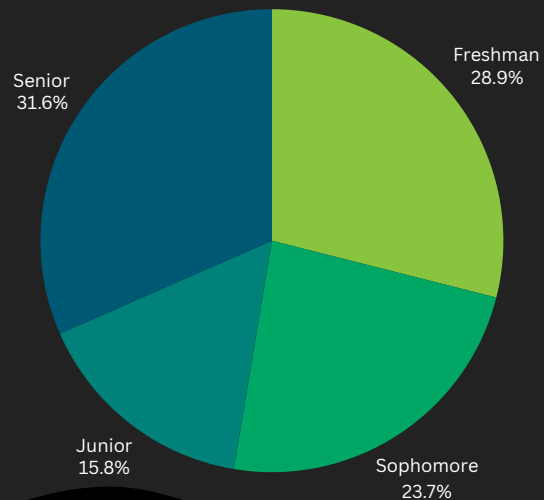
